## What's Going On?



Between now and the summer we have a lot happening. We are wrapping up of many of our school year programs – The Learning Spot, Kidzone, ArtStart, Visions of Science, Artistic Expressions, Think Tank, Women's Wednesdays, etc. So, while we start to prepare for summer, we still have a lot of great programs and events that we continue to focus on.

Not everything ends for the summer. The Bridgeway Early Years program continues year round, some of the adult programming will still meet occasionally throughout the summer and our Sunday Gathering occurs every Sunday all year round.



### **Summer Day Camps**



Every year we have a Summer Day Camp at our Ardglen location and this year we will be having two camps – Ardglen and Orenda. Camp is a great time of games, crafts, songs, trips, sports and lots of fun. This year we will be offering 2 three week camps at each location: July 10 - 28 and July 31 - August 18.
